7. Violence on the Hill

Ted Miller brought up the idea that the club should focus on political action to reduce violence in our district. A lengthy discussion followed.

- A 19-year-old girl was recently murdered in our district
- We should organize a panel to discuss violence on the Hill
- We should bring the issue to the attention of the Police Chief
- Malia Cohen said that violence is frequent; we should have a unified front with the existing Peacemakers group in SF because teaming up with other existing groups will make us more effective
- Sophie Maxwell's office may be able to help
- It's a social and justice issue

An ad hoc committee was formed around this issue, with Ted Miller as chair. First meeting time and place are to be decided.

8. Featured speaker: Anna Wagner from Greenpeace
