• Political Action Committee VP - Rachel Schapira

Alec Bash, from the SF Obama Campaign, gave an update on how we can help in the upcoming presidential election. California is not in play. **Nevada** is a top priority - you can help by phone banking to the states that are still in play. There are 18 states where Obama is campaigning where Kerry didn't even attempt.

At our last meeting we passed a motion to look into an online voting system, the idea being to allow members some extra time decide how to vote for club endorsements after our meeting.
