I. Call to Order

Thomas Bates reported on the Democrats Work event at Gilman Playground in the Bayview, which took place on February 24th and included members of the Club.

Club members discussed a neighborhood design competition to design a new logo for the Club. Vice Chair Alyssa Levine agreed to spearhead the logo competition. Club members discussed their preference to have the t-shirts printed at a union print shop.

Club members discussed getting coverage for Club activities in the View.

A motion was made to move the April meeting to April 10th in order to avoid a conflict with Passover. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

VI. Announcements

Joni Eisen announced that a conference focused on the public financing of elections would be taking place on March 23rd.
