

RESOLUTION ON AFGHANISTAN EXIT STRATEGY

Whereas, it is more than seven years since the start of the war in Afghanistan, and

Whereas, the continued prosecution of this war threatens to undermine the Obama Administration's goals of restored prosperity at home and increased respect for the United States abroad, and

Whereas, it has the support of 95 co-sponsors in the U.S. House of Representatives,

Be it resolved that the Potrero Hill Democratic Club urges Speaker of the House Nancy Pelosi to join Representative Jackie Speier in cosponsoring HR 2404 introduced by Representative James McGovern (D-MA) and urges Senators Barbara Boxer and Diane Feinstein to file similar legislation in the US Senate.

Full text of HR 2404:

A BILL

To require the Secretary of Defense to submit a report to Congress outlining the United States exit strategy for United States military forces in Afghanistan participating in Operation Enduring Freedom.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

Section 1. report on Afghanistan exit strategy.

Not later than December 31, 2009, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to Congress a report outlining the United States exit strategy for United States military forces in Afghanistan participating in Operation Enduring Freedom.
