

June 1, 2010 Meeting Minutes



1. Joni Eisen called the meeting to order.
2. Adams Scow, California Campaigns Director, Food and Water Watch, gave a summary of the water bond that will be on the November ballot, seeking the Club's endorsement of a "NO" vote on the measure
 1. Rachel Schapira made a motion that the PHDC endorse a no vote on the November bond. Chuck Bennett seconded the motion.
 2. Ron Miguel made a motion that we table the vote until we hear both sides. Results: 6 in favor, 8 against, 7 abstain.
 3. Original motion voted on. Results: 12 in favor. Motion passed. The PHDC endorses a no vote on the water bond in the upcoming November election.
3. Joni gave club updates. PhD see volunteers registered voters and distributed information on the upcoming election at the recent health fair.
4. Motion was made & seconded to amend the Club Bylaws regarding board members' responsibilities; according the Bylaws, the motion will be voted on at the next meeting.
5. Club members discussed the proposed letter to the San Francisco Planning Department and the San Francisco Board of Supervisors regarding the Candlestick Point-Hunters Point Shipyard Phase II Final Environmental Impact Report. Club members voted to make some changes to the letter. Club members voted to send the letter. Results: 14 in favor, 0 opposed, 3 abstain.
6. In District 10 Supervisor candidates Chris Jackson and Marlene Tran introduced themselves and explained why they are running for office.
7. Public Defender Jeff Adachi explained a proposal for fixing the city budget shortfall by reforming the pension system. He is seeking signatures to put it on the November ballot.
8. Joni Eisen asked for volunteers for the upcoming member party and auction and the Supervisor Candidate forum. Joni Eisen also encouraged members to support the club's endorsed campaigns.
