

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting Potrero Hill Democratic Club  
Held May 6, 2014**

- The regular meeting of the Potrero Hill Democratic Club (the “Club”) was held at the Potrero Hill Neighborhood House on May 6, 2014.
- Joni Eisen, president of the Club, called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm local time.
- The Club, at Ms. Eisen’s request, approved the agenda for the meeting by acclamation. The Club further approved, as presented, the minutes for the April 1, 2014 meeting of the Club.
- Members of campaigns endorsed by the Club then spoke briefly and offered campaign materials. The Club heard from Jay and Patricia Cheng, of the Betty Yee for Controller campaign, and Tim Hester, of the Yes on Proposition B campaign. Ms. Eisen presented on behalf of the Derek Cressman for Secretary of State campaign.
- The Club then heard from a panel discussing the San Francisco housing crisis. The panel was cosponsored by San Francisco for Democracy. The panel participants were Tim Colen, the Executive Director of the San Francisco Housing Action Coalition, Sara Shortt, the Executive Director of the San Francisco Housing Rights Committee, and Calvin Welch, the founder of the Council of Community Housing Organizations. The panel was moderated by Brad Paul, the Deputy Executive Director of the Association of Bay Area Governments. The panel and the Club engaged in a robust question and answer session.
