Daniel Flores, a candidate for San Francisco Superior Court Judge, Office 20.

Shamann Walton, a candidate for the San Francisco Unified School District School Board.

David Campos, a candidate for the California Assembly, District 17.

Gail Gilman, for Yes on Proposition K.
