

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting Potrero Hill Democratic Club  
Held July 7, 2015**

- The regular meeting of the Potrero Hill Democratic Club (the “Club”) was held at the Potrero Hill Neighborhood House on July 7, 2015.
- Joni Eisen, president of the Club, called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm local time.
- Ms. Eisen asked the membership if there were any changes to the agenda. There being none, the agenda for the meeting was passed by acclamation.
- Ms. Eisen presented proposed amendments to the Bylaws that would affect the voting threshold for endorsements in multi-seat races. This was the first announcement before the Club of the amendment. Upon a motion duly made, seconded and accepted, it was moved that the Club, as per its Bylaws, consider the amendment at its next meeting.
- Ms. Eisen then announced that the Club’s executive committee had discussed expanding its boundaries and creating a Potrero Hill-Bayview Democratic Club. She asked the membership for any feedback on the idea.
- Ms. Eisen then introduced the program for the meeting. Maxine Anderson, longtime board member of San Francisco for Democracy and league of Women Voters SF, moderated a Black Lives Matter panel discussion. Participating on the panel were:
  - Rheema Callaway, Black Priorities Project Organizer for Causa Justa::Just Cause.
  - Stevon Cook, CEO of Mission Bit.
  - Joe Marshall, founder of Alive & Free/Omega Boys Club, SF Police Commissioner.
  - Thea Matthews, campus activist and Black Lives Matter movement participant.
  - Vanesa Moses, Program Co-Director of Causa Justa::Just Cause.
- Ms. Eisen then made the following announcements:
  - A District 10 Community Forum hosted by Assembly Member David Chiu and Supervisor Malia Cohen would take place on July 11 at 11:00 am, at the CCSF Southeast Center (1800 Oakdale).
  - A Democratic Club Unity Mixer hosted by the D5 Democratic Club would take place on July 29 at 6:00 pm, at Madrone Art Bar, 500 Divisadero.
  - The Club’s next meeting would take place on August 4 at 7:00 pm, at the Potrero Hill Neighborhood House. The Club would host a CCSF Trustee Candidate Forum and a debate among the candidates for Sheriff.
- There being no further business before the Club, Ms. Eisen adjourned the meeting at 8:55 pm.
