1. Why are you running for the DCCC and what do you hope to accomplish if elected or re-elected?

I have been an active Democrat since 1964. I have attended numerous Democratic National Conventions, and State Conventions. I worked on dozens of campaigns to elect Democrats at every level, most recently Obama for President in 2008 and 2012. I founded the Internet Caucus of the CDP in 1995, and the Progressive Caucus in 2007.

I believe that the main purpose of the DCCC is Voter Registration, GOTV, and Funding and Operating our local Democratic Campaigns (especially 2016 US President).

I will continue to attend your Potrero Hill Democratic Club events and programs, and work with your leadership on issues vital to Potrero and to San Francisco.

2. Please describe your current and past community activism.

I have been a lifelong progressive Democrat working for LGBT, Women, People of Color, Economic, Social and Environmental Justice, Choice, for more than 50 years. I was an organizer of the SF Democratic Party's Permanent Precinct Captain Program and on the Fundraising

I attend every DCCC Meeting and Event. We had an enormously successful Democratic Party Debate Watch Party last month at Local 261. I was delighted that Potrero Hill was a co-sponsor. I helped to re-start the College Democrats Chapter on the SF State Campus in 2002 to ensure that young people are engaged in our Party at all levels. I am a 35 year Member/Officer of the Harvey Milk LGBT Democratic Club. SF National Organization for Women. I am very active with SF Tenants Union; Cesar Chavez Celebration Committee, San Francisco Tomorrow; Sierra Club PAC, and Living Wage Coalition.
