## Minutes of the a Special Meeting Potrero Hill Democratic Club Held September 15, 2015

- A special endorsement meeting of the Potrero Hill Democratic Club (the "Club") was held at the Potrero Hill Neighborhood House on September 15, 2015.
- Joni Eisen, president of the Club, called the meeting to order at 7:07 pm local time. She noted the presence of a quorum.
- Ms. Eisen asked the membership if there were any changes to the agenda. There being none, the revised agenda for the meeting was approved by acclamation.
- Ms. Eisen presented the minutes of the August 4, 2015, and September 1, 2015 meetings of the Club for approval. No changes to the minutes were proposed, and they were approved by acclamation.
- Ms. Eisen introduced Brent Turner, who have an update on open-source voting, which the Club had previously endorsed, and which will be before the Elections Commission in the following months.
- Ms. Eisen introduced San Francisco City Attorney Dennis Herrera, who discussed his incumbent, unopposed candidacy with the Club.
- The Club then considered some of the San Francisco propositions on the November ballot: The Club heard from:
  - Supervisor Katy Tang, in favor of, and the Club's executive committee, reading the opposition argument, without endorsement, for, Proposition B, which provides for expanding paid parental leave for City employees.
  - Eric Brooks, in opposition to Proposition G and in favor of Proposition H, which provide definitions for clean, green and renewable energy sources.
- The Club then hosted a debate among Francisco Herrera, Amy Farah Weiss and Dan Kappler, candidates for mayor. J.R. Eppler, the Club's secretary, moderated the debate.
- Ms. Eisen then made the following announcements:
  - The Club would host its Annual "Shop Local" Silent Auction & Party from 5:00 to 8:00 pm at Dogpatch Saloon, 3<sup>rd</sup> Street @ 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. Donations and food for the potluck were solicited.
  - The Club's next meeting would take place on October 6 at 7:00 pm, at the Potrero Hill Neighborhood House.
- Ms. Eisen requested that Club members return their endorsement ballots.
- There being no further business before the Club, Ms. Eisen adjourned the meeting at 8:55 pm.
- Following the meeting, the Executive Committee of the Club counted the endorsement ballots that had been cast at the meeting. Following the count, the Club announced that it had made the following endorsements:
